

ROUTE:

The ride is approximately 70 miles (2 hours plus refreshment stop)

70 miles Across Dartmoor and Mid Devon. Start and finish at the Woodleigh Coach House, EX6 6JL. Summer start time 09:00 for a 09:30 departure.

Taking the old A30 through Cheriton Bishop to Whiddon
Down Turning right onto the A3124 to North Tawton Cross
Left onto the A3072 then right through Jacobstowe
Left onto the A386 to Folly Gate/Sourton Cross/Tavistock.
Before Tavistock left onto the B3357 and right into Princetown for a
comfort/refreshment stop. At the Old Police Station Cafe.

After a break leave Princetown on the B3212 to Two Bridges Left to continue on
B3212 to Moretonhampstead
Left onto A382 to Whiddon Down
Old A30 to finish at Woodleigh Coach House

The ride will be offered on a first come basis, so all Associates/Members please email me at david.mudge@environment-agency.gov.uk and I will confirm if they have been successful and they accept the COVID-19 restrictions that we are currently adhering to, which will be forwarded onto them when they provide their email addresses.
